Directions to registration: ALL DORM CAMPERS MUST CHECK IN AT UD's Laird Campus between 10:30-1:00 p.m.

ALL DORM REGISTRATION STARTS AT PENCADER DINING HALL 1ST FLOOR

All Hotel/Day campers will check in at the site of their first contest to receive their reversible jersey.

Laird Campus DORM MAP FOR DIRECTIONS INCLUDED (Watch for Camp Signs to direct you)

From the north: Take I-95 South to Delaware Exit 1-B; Route 896 North. Continue straight approximately two miles. Follow on campus directions

ON CAMPUS DIRECTIONS: At the intersection of Rt 4 and Route 896 North continue straight on South College Ave (past on the right Fred P. Rullo Stadium, the Bob Carpenter/Sports Convocation Center, Delaware Stadium). Look for camp signs. Continue past the athletic complex continuing on 896 north over the Amtrak Bridge continuing on S. College Ave through campus until you reach the end of South College at a "T" which is main street. You must take a left on Main Street. Continue to the end of main street and the road will split three ways – bear right at the Deer Park Restaurant onto New London Road/896 North. Go straight through the next light and down the hill going past the UD Courtyard – Marriott Hotel. Take the second right and park in the parking lot on the left. Follow the signs to the registration tents or buildings. That is where check in will be. The dorms for camp will be at the Christiana Towers, George Read and Thomas McKean and James Smith dorms. These dorms have air conditioning.

From the south: Take I-95 North to Delaware Exit 1; Route 896 North. Continue straight approximately two miles.

Check In Information

Check in and registration time will be 10:30-1:00 p.m. Sunday, July 22 (day /hotel campers will check in at the site of their first game to receive their jersey and to confirm their attendance at camp). For transportation to the campus from airports and Amtrak contact Delaware Express Shuttle Company (302-454-7800 ask for Tony x 623) for transportation from Philadelphia airport or the Wilmington train station. The camp will be done Wednesday, July 25 from 11:30-1:30 depending on your play off games.

EQUIPMENT

Items to bring:

A. All the necessary lacrosse equipment-**helmet: stick: gloves: arm pads : shoulder pads: mouth pieces are required the camp is not responsible for replacement parts to sticks , helmets, etc. please bring back up accessory items for your equipment.**

B. Sneakers (for astro turf): spikes (for grass and field turf fields) must be brought to every game session – you will play on both surfaces at each session.

C. **Water jug or large water thermos** – trainers will supply water **but not** cups to drink with (FREE STX WATER BOTTLES WILL BE GIVEN OUT AT CHECK IN FOR DORM CAMPERS)

D. Sheets –pillow & pillow cases-blankets- towels

UD Parent –Camper Waiver off web site and a Physician Note is needed

1) A PHYSICIAN'S CERTIFICATION OF GOOD HEALTH (A NOTE FROM YOUR PERSONAL PHYSICIAN INDICATING YOUR SON IS IN GOOD HEALTH TO PARTICIPATE)

OR

2) A COPY OF A SCHOOL PHYSICAL GIVEN DURING THE YEAR

REGISTRATION

- Registration will take place from 10:30-1:00 p.m. at PENCADER DINNING HALL 1ST FLOOR Campers staying at the dorms must check in at registration at the North Laird Campus 10:30-1:00 to receive their dorm room assignment, dorm key, building entrance PDI card or build flob, final game schedule and shuttle bus times. Hotel / Day campers can meet at the site of their first game. Day campers will check in at the game site to receive their reversible jersey. Each team staying at the dorms will be assigned a team manager to assist the team coaches. These team managers will ensure attendance at every meeting, orderly conduct at all times, proper behavior at the dorms, dining hall and on campus.

FIRST SHUTTLE BUS RIDE

- Each player will meet at their assigned team area for roll call at the top parking lot above the dorms where registration took place to take roll and prepare to load the shuttle bus. **Team signs will be placed so every player will know where to meet each time for roll call prior to loading the shuttle buses. Signs will be posted in alphabetical order in top parking lots at Laird near the dorms. YOUR TEAM MANAGER WILL BE THERE FOR ROLL CALL.** Players, team managers and coaches must look at their schedule to know whether the game is at the UD athletic complex or Glasgow High School or if they walk to North Campus Fields. There will be designated spots for UD athletic fields buses and another area for Glasgow buses. All teams playing at North Campus will take roll on the field turf in front of Pencader Dining Hall. **Meals are not provided for Hotel / Day Campers.**
- There is a \$85 dollar charge for any dorm keys that are not returned at the end of the week and a \$50 charge for the PDI building access key . Players staying in a dorm will receive a meal bracelet for the dining hall. **You will not receive a replacement bracelet if you lose it.** The access key allows entrance into your dorm building. Each camper will receive a key lanyard at registration for his key to his room. It is recommended not to play with the lanyard, key, and access card on while at camp. University dorms have a security system that requires an access key in order to get inside to the dorm rooms.

JERSEYS

- Each camper will receive his Hotbeds Jersey at the field where the team's first game is scheduled. The team manager will distribute the jersey making sure that each number corresponds to the number given the player in the college coach's recruiting booklet. College coaches will have information booklets with rosters, and personal information. This is why it is important to wear the Hotbeds jersey at every contest to maximize your recruiting exposure.

RECRUITING CAMP--- READ THIS!!!!!!!!!!!!!!

- It is important that every camper know that the coaching association is a very tight knit organization. How well you represent yourself could effect your reputation in the coaching community. Coaches communicate with each other on players and a good and bad reputation will spread rapidly amongst the coaching community. Your goal at this type of camp is to represent yourself; your high school and your family as well as you can both on the field and off the field. Each player is expected to display the best behavior while at camp. In past years we have sent players home along with charging their families for any dorm damage while also notifying their high school administration and coaches of any undesirable behavior. Your behavior can follow you through out your career. College coaches will be notified of anyone who displays inappropriate behavior or conduct at the camp.

MEALS / DINING HALL FOR DORM PLAYERS ONLY!!!!!!

- Each dorm player will receive either a wrist band for the camp meal pass. Both the lower floor and top floor of Pencader will be available to eat meals. This will keep people moving during dining hall sessions
- **Dorm campers have paid for on-campus meals... Day campers / hotel campers will not receive meal passes. They will be required to eat on their own.**

DORM CAMPERS WITH CARS

- Campers who drive cars will need to get a parking pass from public safety otherwise you will take the chance of getting a parking ticket and maybe towed. Parking behind our basketball complex (Bob Carpenter Center) is a possible place without a parking pass but you will be taking a chance that you could still be ticketed. A four day parking pass is the safest way to avoid a ticket. The camp will not be responsible for parking tickets or towing charges. **ALL PARKING MUST BE EITHER IN FRONT OF DELAWARE STADIUM OR BEHIND THE BOB CARPENTER CENTER AT UD ATHLETIC CONTESTS OR BEHIND GLASGOW HIGH AT THE HIGH SCHOOL. YOU WILL BE TICKETED AND TOWED IF YOU ARE NOT PARKING IN A DESIGNATED SPACE. THE CAMP WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR TICKETS OR TOWING!!!!!!**

HOTELS

- Area hotels may give a discount for a certain number of rooms reserved for the Battle of the Hotbeds Tournament. Most have indicated 10 rooms or more. Recommended hotels: Embassy Suites = 302 368 8000, UD Courtyard Marriott = 302-737-0900, Homewood Suites 302-453-9700, Sleep Inn 302-453-1700 and Holiday Inn Express off of I-95...GO TO WEB SITE AT REGISTRATION PAGE AT BOTTOM IS PRINT OUT

PARKING FOR SPECTATORS.....IMPORTANT

- **Parking for the events..... there is no parking in the following places for spectators... all parking needs to be done for the UD athletic Fields either in front of the Delaware Football Stadium, behind the Bob Carpenter Basketball center, or in front of Fred Rust Ice Rink.**
- **For Glasgow High ... all parking must be done behind the High School... the front is needed for high school Summer school and special summer program.**
- **For North Campus....all parking must be done in the parking lot corner of Cleveland and N. Campus Rd.**
- **NO PARKING (UD ATHLETIC CENTER) AROUND THE FIELD TURFS FIELD, IN RULLO STADIUM, DOWN THE ACCESS ROAD TO THE POOL FIELDS (RD ADJACENT TO THE SOCCER AND BASEBALL FIELDS) AND AROUND THE POOL FIELDS! (GLASGOW HIGH) IN FRONT OF GLASGOW HIGH**
CARS WILL BE TICKETED AND POTENTIALLY TOWED

Dorm Rooms

- Team managers will be responsible to making sure that the dorms are kept clean and that at the end of camp all trash will be taken to the outside dumpsters. The PDI card or flobs are coded for 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. no camper will be able to enter their dorm room with their card after 11 p.m. **YOU MAY NOT SWITCH DORMS – ALL DORM ASSIGNMENTS ARE FINAL!!!! YOU WILL BE SENT HOME IF YOU SWITCH DORMS OR MOVE FURNITURE FROM ONE DORM ROOM TO ANOTHER!!!! NO QUESTIONS ON THIS REQUEST. YOU'RE HERE TO PLAY LACROSSE.**
- **EACH CAMPER WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR WAKING UP ON TIME IN THE MORNING - YOU MUST BRING AN ALARM CLOCK !**

Camp Areas for Dorm Campers

- The dorms and athletic areas are the only places that campers are allowed during camp. No dorm camper may leave the dorms to go into town. Anyone found outside the North Campus dorm area during will be immediately sent home.

Registration Procedures (for dorm campers)

- As you take a right off of 896/New London Road (follow signs) park in the upper parking lots to your right as you drive in.
- Registration FOLLOW THE SIGNS TO PENCADER DINING HALL... WALK IN THE FRONT DOORS OF FIRST FLOOR DINING HALL... IT FACES THE LARGE FIELD TURF AREA IN THE MIDDLE OF THE DORMS..... IT IS AIR CONDITIONED.
- **Step one:** Check in first in one of five alphabetical lines by last name – you will receive a packet with your dorm assignment
- **Step Two:** Go to the Medical Station IF YOU HAVE NOT MAILED OR EMAIL YOUR your Parent/Waiver and Physician's clearance or bring a second copy. **Do not contact the directors to see if they are in – we do not have the time to look up and return calls or emails- a second copy assures you it is in.**
- **Step three:** YOU WILL BE DIRECTED TO YOUR DORM To pick up keys and PDI building cards The Conference Center and Housing will sign you in and you will sign for your key and PDI card.
- **Step Four:** Review your playing schedule and be early for roll call and to jump on the bus for the playing fields.

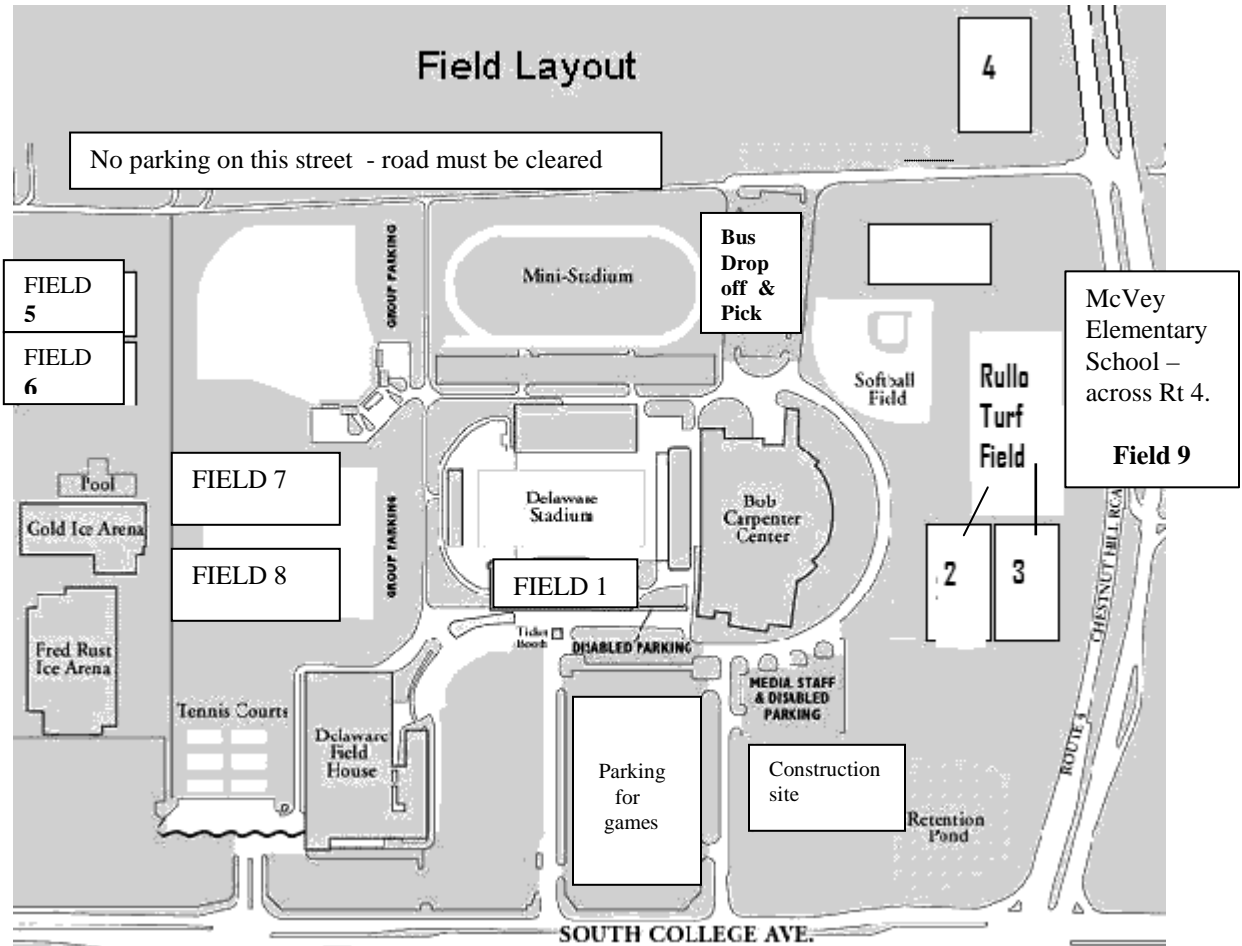
UD SECURITY WILL DIRECT PARKING ON SUNDAY AND WEDNESDAY

BATTLE OF THE HOT BEDS- 3 SITES

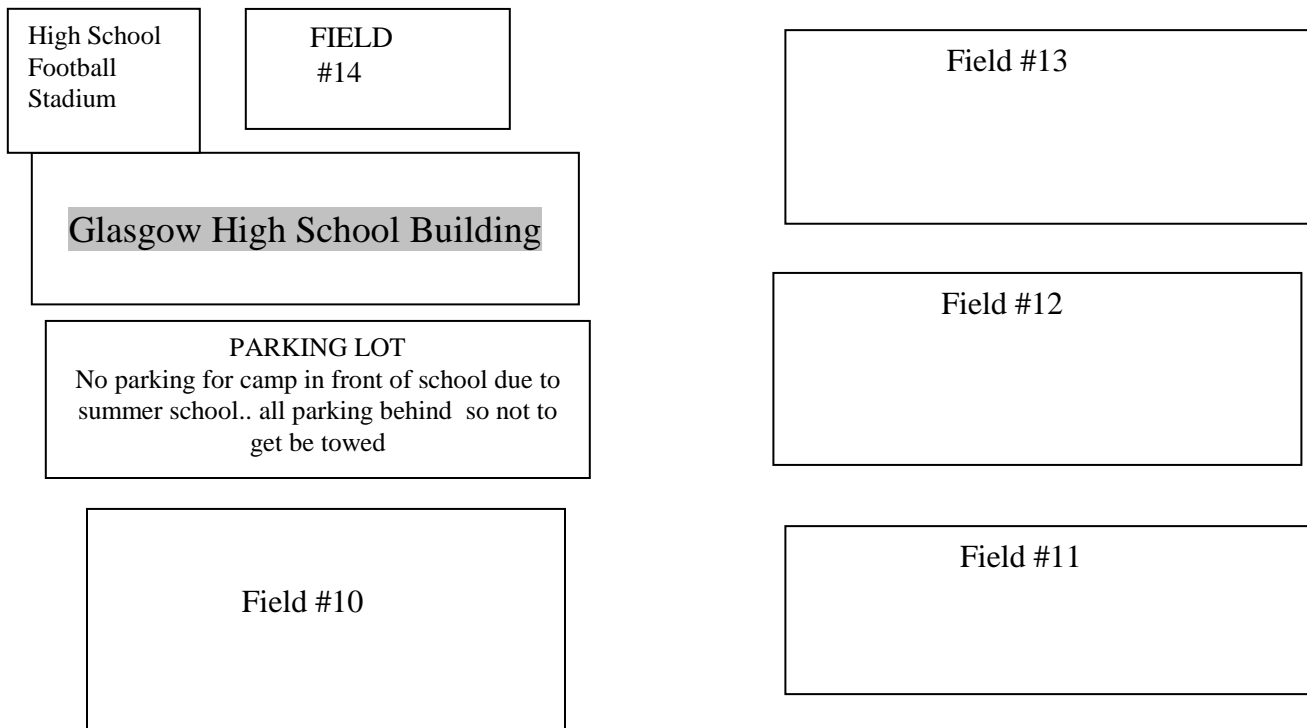
FIELD LAYOUTS UD ATHLETIC COMPLEX, GLASGOW HIGH SCHOOL, AND NORTH CAMPUS FIELDS BEHIND CARPENTER SPORTS BUILDING

- BUSES WILL DROP OFF & PICK UP TEAMS DIRECTLY BEHIND THE BOB CARPENTER BASKETBALL CENTER AT UD OR FRONT OF GLASGOW HIGH
- AT THE DORMS BE EARLY FOR LOADING 15 MINUTES PRIOR TO LOADING THE BUS – ALWAYS CHECK IN WITH YOU TEAM MANAGER FOR ROLL CALL



TO GLASGOW HIGH FIELDS

From the UD Athletic Complex take 896 south over I-95. Got through the light (Intersection of Old Baltimore Pike and 896 North). Next left will take you into Glasgow High and bear right through the parking lot and the fields are directly in front and to the side.



TO NORTH CAMPUS FIELDS BEHIND CARPENTER RECREATION CENTER

BEGIN WALKING 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO GAME TIME

FIELD 15-16- 17 (Field 17 may be unavailable due to addition to our recreation center.. we will know early summer) ARE DIRECTLY BEHIND CARPENTER SPORTS BUILDING

- 1.CAMPERS WILL WALK FROM DORMS OVER WALKING BRIDGE
2. UP NORTH COLLEGE AVE TOWARDS MAIN STREET – ONCE OVER TRAIN TRACK... TAKE LEFT THROUGH PARKING LOT TO FIELDS
3. ALL SPECTATORS MUST PARK IN PARKING LOT ON CORNER OF CLEVELAND AVE AND NORTH COLLEGE OR YOU WILL GET TICKETED.
